


How to Ace Your Video Interview





The Basics

- Research the company in advance
- Ensure your device is charged
- Give 100% of your attention to the interview

What to Wear

- Dress professionally from head to toe
- Opt for neutral colors
- Avoid busy patterns

Lighting Dos and Don'ts

- Find a well-lit area
- Opt for natural light when possible
- Avoid backlighting

Set the Scene before Going Onscreen

- Tidy the area in the camera frame
- Close doors & windows; turn off TV & music
- Set phone to "Do Not Disturb"



Body Language

55% of communication comes from body language. Only 7% of communication comes from words.







Show open body language

20% of interviewers said applicants who sat with their arms crossed were not considered Maintain good posture & eye contact

65% of interviewers said candidates who failed to make eye contact didn't get the role Smile now & then

40% of interviewers said a lack of a smile is a good enough reason not to consider a candidate

- Practice, Practice, Practice
 Record yourself & review the video
- Practice with others in a mock interview
- No need to memorize everything
